

Moving Out Checklist

1. Declutter

Donate or sell anything you don't need to bring with you. The less you have, the less your move will cost.

2. Make a budget and compare quotes

Figure out how much you want to spend on your move. Get quotes from at least three moving companies to compare.

3. Book a mover or truck rental

Book at least a month in advance, if possible.

4. Figure out a labeling and packing system

Label and pack one box and one room at a time based on the contents and which room it should be placed in.

5. Organize your documents

Keep all your important documents, including moving contracts and policies, in a folder. Bring the folder with you when you move.

6. Change your address

Update your address with USPS to get your mail forwarded.

7. Cancel your utilities

Call your service provider and set a date to end the service.

8. Deep clean

If you're renting, clean up the place before you leave so you get your deposit back.

1. Set up utilities

5. Change your locks
